


May 25, 2008: Tornadoes Strike the Northern Twin Cities Metro


Event Synopsis

A strong low pressure system moved into western Minnesota early Sunday during the 2008 Memorial Day weekend. Moisture return ahead of this feature, along with favorable upper level jet stream positioning, generated supercell thunderstorms during the afternoon and evening in central Minnesota and west central Wisconsin. The thunderstorms produced widespread large hail damage, especially along and north of the Interstate 94 corridor, from Monticello to the northern Twin Cities metro area, and into west central Wisconsin. The supercell thunderstorms also spawned tornadoes in multiple locations, including near Coon Rapids and Hugo.




May 25, 2008 Surface Weather Map: 4 pm




Radar Reflectivity at 4:38 PM CDT, May 25, 2008




Radar Reflectivity at 4:51 PM CDT, May 25, 2008




Radar Reflectivity at 4:59 PM CDT, May 25, 2008




Radar Reflectivity (terminal doppler weather radar) at 4:39 PM CDT, May 25, 2008

Tornadoes

...Summary of tornadoes from Sunday, May 25, 2008...

Tornado #1 (An EF-1 from Coon Rapids to Blaine):

At 4:35 p.m., the first tornado of the day touched down in Coon Rapids, at the northeast corner of the intersection of Highway 10 and Main Street, and moved east-southeast. It lifted off at 4:47 p.m. in central Blaine, near the TPC Golf Club, just east of Highway 65 and north of 109th Avenue. The total path length was six miles and its width was about 100 yards. Numerous trees were toppled or snapped, and some roof damage was noted. One house was pushed off its foundation. A number of sheds and garages were destroyed. This tornado produced EF-1 damage, with winds between 86 and 110 mph, and was confined to Anoka County.

Tornado #2 (an EF-3 from Lino Lakes to Hugo):

The most damaging tornado touched down in the eastern side of Lino Lakes, at the eastern shore of Peltier Lake in eastern Anoka County. The time of this was 4:55 p.m., according to Lino Lakes police. It knocked over trees and lifted boat docks, then tracked east and crossed Interstate 35E. A few barns, grain bins and silos were damaged. The tornado then intensified as it moved into northwestern Washington County and a subdivision just north of downtown Hugo. This was about 5:01 p.m. It was at this point that the tornado caused EF-3 damage, with winds in the 136 to 165 mph range, and

sadly, claimed the life of a two year old boy. The tornado dissipated around 5:05 p.m. in the eastern portion of Hugo, a little north of Irish Avenue and 140th street. The total path length was six miles, and its width was about 1/8 mile.

Tornado #3 (an EF-0 in rural northern Washington County):

Five miles east of the dissipation point of the Hugo tornado, a brief tornado developed and tracked across portions of the Warner Nature Reserve, toppling hundreds of trees. It touched down at 5:10 p.m., was on the ground for one mile, had a maximum width of 50 yards, and dissipated at 5:12 p.m. This was about three miles southwest of Marine on St. Croix.

Tornado #4 (an EF-0 from Marine on St. Croix into Wisconsin):

This tornado developed in northeastern Washington County, in the northern edge of Marine on St. Croix. It crossed the St. Croix River, and moved into St. Croix County and then Polk County in Wisconsin. It dissipated 3.5 miles southwest of East Farmington, just north of the Polk and St. Croix County line. The tornado was rated an EF-0, had a path length of 1.25 miles, and a maximum width of 50 yards. The damage was confined to a few hundred trees, some of which fell on homes in Marine on St. Croix. This tornado was estimated to have touched down at 5:15 p.m. and dissipated at about 5:18 p.m.

Tornado #5 (an EF-0 north-northwest of Menomonie)

A four mile long, 50 yard wide EF-0 was determined to have touched down in extreme northwestern Dunn County, 20 to 25 miles north-northwest of Menomonie. It touched down at about 5:55 p.m. 3.5 miles northwest of Connorsville, and dissipated around 6:00 p.m. five miles north-northeast of Connorsville. Numerous trees were downed, along with a couple barns, silos, and outbuildings.

Storm Reports

Damaging Wind...

The storm that produced these tornadoes also produced very strong downburst winds, with wind speeds estimated to have occasionally reached 65 to 85 mph. Isolated trees were felled along the storm path due to these winds. Evidence of a rear flank downdraft was often noted in the damage pattern, and some very experienced storm chasers described witnessing an impressive cascading rear flank downdraft. Some of the winds caused damage to houses, garages and outbuildings.

Large Hail...


Many of the storms produced a prodigious amount of hail, and much of it was quite large in size. Some hail in Lino Lakes was still on the ground for 20 hours after the storm. Hail larger than golf balls was reported from St Cloud to north of Annandale, then eastward to Anoka and Andover, Blaine, Lino Lakes, Hugo, Star Prairie (Wisconsin), and across southern Polk and northern St Croix Counties.

The final report of very large hail came from 6 miles north-northwest of Chippewa Falls, WI, where baseball size hail was reported.

The largest hail reported was softball size (4.25 inches in diameter) just north of Burkhardt, WI (St Croix County). The largest hail reported in

Minnesota was 3.5 inches in diameter, which occurred 4 miles south-southeast of Silver Creek in Wright County.
